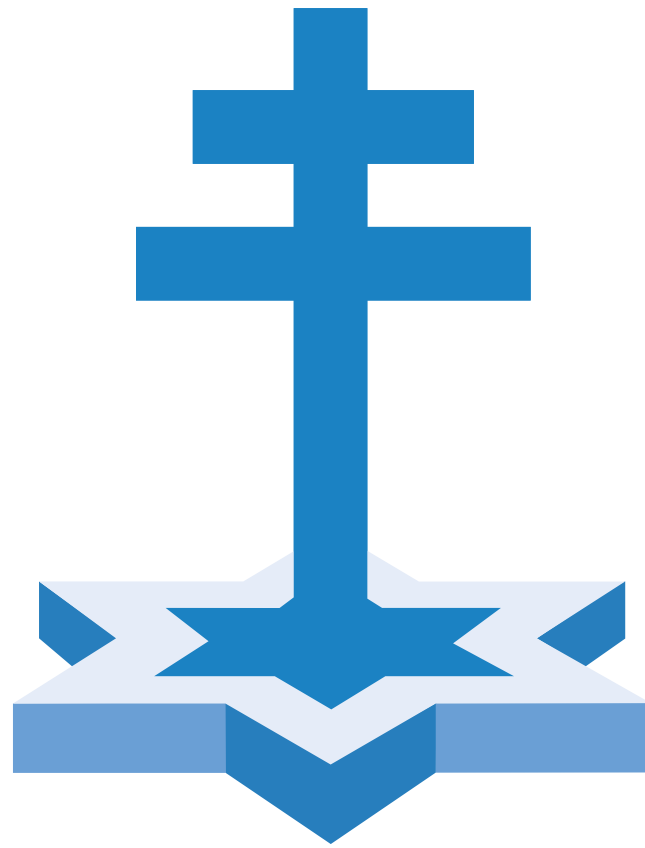


PADRINHO ALFREDO'S NEW HYMN: 'LIFE'

NO TO THE PL 490

Through an official notice, ICEFLU in solidarity with indigenous nations, expressed its repudiation of 'PL 490' (Brazilian Law Project #490), which represents a step backwards in relation to human rights and the preservation of nature. The original peoples, guardians of natural medicines and the forest for a long time, must have their rights respected and the demarcation of their lands guaranteed, as their sovereignty and self-determination are fundamental for the future of the planet and of all humanity.

The Technical Scientific Department of ICEFLU has already started its work fronts. Next steps, among other goals, the organization of an official protocol for record-keeping and reception of people for the Associated Churches of ICEFLU is planned, also specialized assistance in the mental health area and the construction of a virtual library with academic and scientific information about the Santo Daime.

JUNE FESTIVAL

During June and July, the Irmandade stayed connected and celebrated the dates of the June Festival. There were five Lives: Santo Antônio (in partnership with the Céu do Mar church), São João, Madrinha Rita's birthday, São Pedro and the work of Mestre's Passage. Altogether, 27 churches sang along with Céu do Mapiá. Adding all the works together, there were around 43,500 views of the online broadcasting. It was a festival celebrated worldwide in union.

SOCIAL ASSISTANCE

AMVCM and Santa Casa de Cura, with the support of ICEFLU, invite to another collective effort in favor of communities in the forest. With visitation suspended for over a year, and essential income-generating activities interrupted, it was necessary to create a Social Assistance Fund that responds in an emergency manner to the health, food and logistics demands of the community's daily life.

After the **Women's Workgroup of ICEFLU** meeting discussing Daimista Gardens, the Network of Daimista Gardeners was born, which will initially be coordinated by the Céu de Maria church. The idea is to strengthen the exchange of knowledge between the churches on the management of the 'reinados': from the cultivation of the 'rainhas' and agroforestry species, to the organization of records and dialogues for the preparation of the "Notebook of the Rainha" with bibliographical research and organization of data brought by the gardeners.

ECOLOGICAL COMMUNITY CÉU DOS ESTORRÕES

Former rubber plantation Adélia, located in Ipixuna/AM, was where Padrinho Sebastião worked and raised a family together with Madrinha Rita. In search of his family roots, Padrinho Alfredo returned to the Juruá region 50 years after leaving the rubber plantation. The plantation at that time was for sale, and was acquired and transformed in 1996 into the Céu dos Estorrões community. Today, with 20 families, the community is formed by former rubber tappers and riverside dwellers, most of them small farmers.

LINHA DO TUCUM CRAFT WORKSHOP



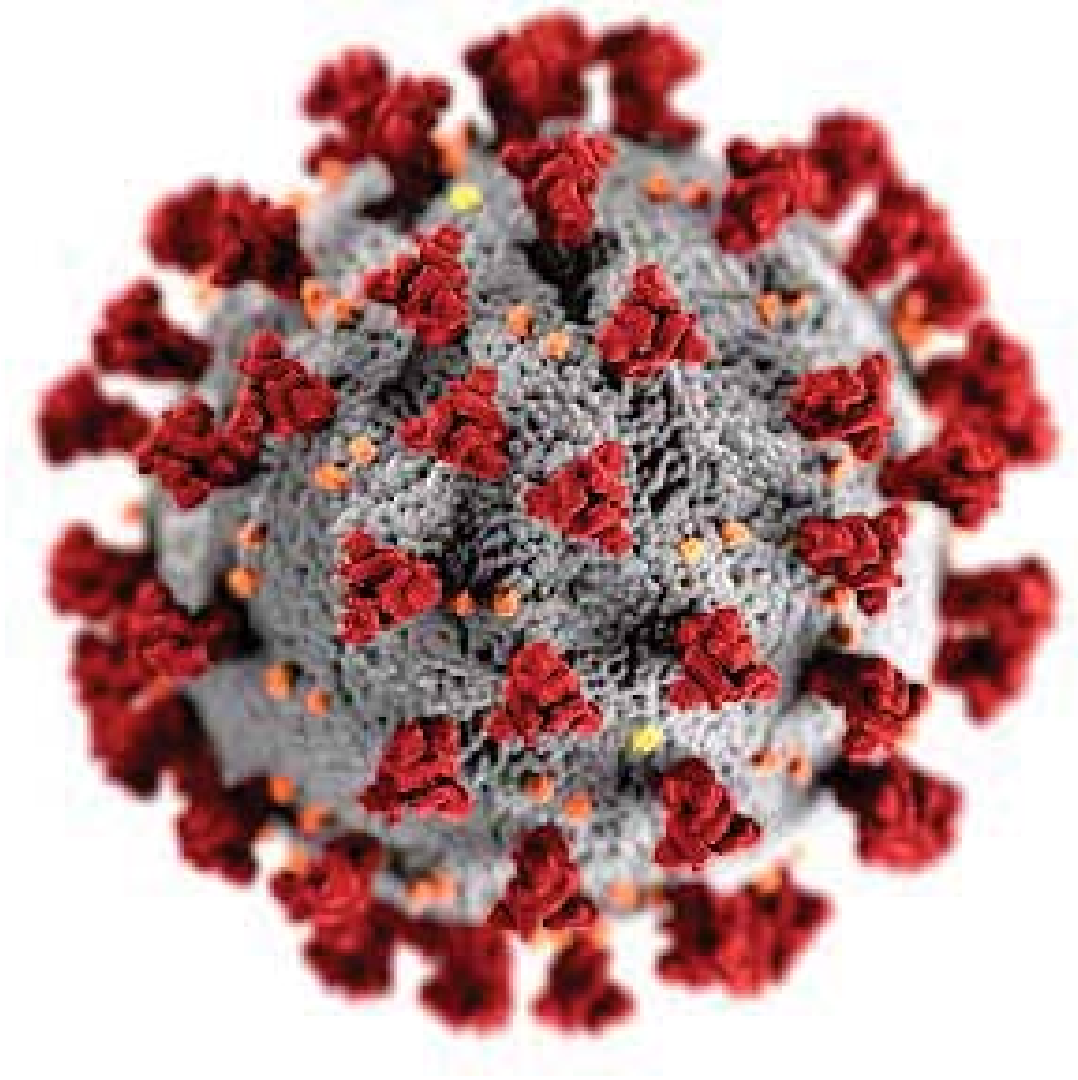
The Educational Biodesign Project, in the Céu dos Estorrões community, encourages artistic activity as a professional qualification for the personal and financial development of women, young people and families. The initiative keeps alive the millenary tradition of spinning the Tucum thread, and craftsmanship using seeds and wooden forest products. Graduate artisans become teachers and pass on their knowledge to young apprentices in the community.

TIME OF UNION AND RENEWAL



While the renovation of Santa Casa de Cura continues, the focus of the moment is the union of the people of Mapiá, who are mobilizing to continue the community work efforts to benefit the common areas: the community school, church, Jardim da Natureza, farmlands, main square, Community Kitchen, among others. The Residents' Association is in charge of organizing this work, which has the support of the Forest Management team and Santa Casa.



COVID-19

Vila Céu do Mapiá and Fazenda once again presented cases of Covid-19 - 3 and 8 cases respectively. AMVCM provided the purchase of more tests, masks and analgesics, in addition to refilling oxygen cylinders. Once again, a state of isolation was decreed, and activities were cancelled for two weeks. To meet the demands, resources from the World Solidarity Campaign are being used.

WEB AND FM RADIO BROADCASTING

To restart the broadcasting, the platform was reorganized, the daily and weekly schedule was updated, timetables were reprogrammed and the antennas were realigned. There was also a special program for the days of the Saints, with tributes, stories, songs and hymns. Many families from Céu do Mapiá accompanied the broadcasting of the June Festival's lives on Rádio Jagube, which registered more than 2,700 listeners connected.





PROJECT BENEFITS RIVERSIDE FAMILIES OF THE PURUS

Cooperar, with the support of Instituto Nova Era, effectively reached 63% of the goal of the covenant (nº 20243) with the Foundation of the Brazil Bank, with the amount of R\$460,861.00, through acquisitions made and contracted services. In the six months of the project, the cooperative is carrying out its institutional mission, promoting sustainable activities, along with the productive axes: Native Cocoa, Community Forest Management and Extractive Agroindustry.

The third newsletter of Cooperar's Agroecology and Food Sovereignty Program was published. This edition presents the actions carried out in the community work, the mobilization and participation of community residents, and the results collected so far. It also brings special testimonies from Padrinho Alfredo, Madrinha Júlia, Padrinho Alex Polari and Pedro Vicente about the taskforces led by Padrinho Sebastião.

PEDRO DÁRIO

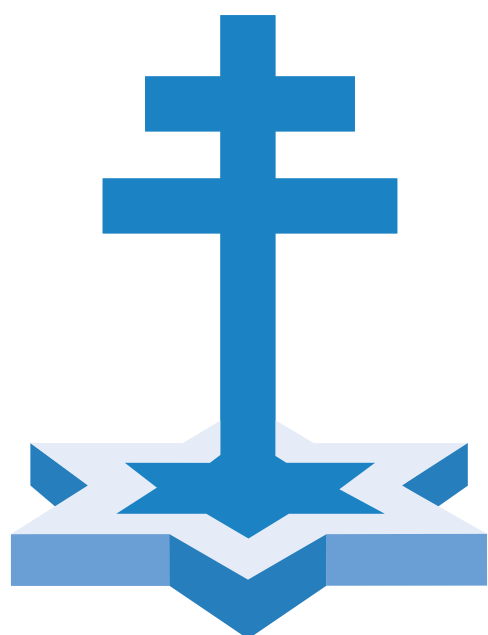
